Conditions of Entry

1. Each person may play in one event only.
2. Entry Fee \$6 per student. The Hollioake Park Sports Association will invoice each school for the number of entrants.
3. Entries need to be sent to HPSA Primary Sports Challenge,

By the due date, Friday April 23rd.
4. Cheques should be made out to the Hollioake Park Sports Association Inc and sent to the above address.
5. Competition times will generally be between 9.15am and 2.15pm – please inform the organisers if your school has travel restrictions.
6. Presentations of trophies for each sport and the Shield will be held at the WIN Minerdome at 2.30pm. Buses should be arranged for a 2.45pm departure.
7. Smaller schools may (at the organisers discretion) combine to form a team e.g. Seven Hills Cluster.
8. Schools not able to field a full team covering all sports may enter as a school is able, e.g. boys badminton, girls tennis etc. If a school is fully represented in all sports, then it may enter a second team or part thereof to a maximum of two teams. These teams will be treated as separate entries, players cannot move between teams and will be designated by a separate colour e.g. Forest St Red and Forest St Blue.
9. It is expected that schools will enter their best possible teams with no restrictions on age or grade.
10. Boys and Girls will play in separate teams and competitions.
11. Perpetual Shield Points system is as follows :-

Teams for each sport, boys and girls will score:

1 st – 25 points	2 nd – 20 points	3 rd – 18 points
4 th – 17 points	5 th – 16 points	6 th – 15 points
7 th – 14 points	8 th – 13 points	9 th – 12 points
10 th – 11 points	11 th – 10 points	12 th – 9 points
13 th – 8 points	14 th – 7 points	15 th – 6 points
16 th – 5 points	17 th – 4 points	18 th – 3 points

All other competing teams will receive 2 points
